



## Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Testbourne Ltd has prepared this statement in response to customer enquiries regarding compliance with Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act.

Testbourne Ltd is committed to sourcing materials and components from companies that share our values of respect for human rights and dignity. It is our goal to avoid procuring products containing “Conflict Minerals” .... tin, tungsten, tantalum, gold which originate from within the Democratic Republic of Congo and surrounding countries designated as a “conflict region”.

Testbourne Ltd has contacted our suppliers of tin, tungsten, tantalum and gold to obtain their assurances and appropriate reporting templates that only “conflict free minerals” are used in the materials and components that we procure from them.

Testbourne Ltd has no indication that the products we supply have been sourced from mines or smelters from CAHRAs that can be shown to be funding confounding conflict or other illegal activities.

Based on their responses Testbourne Ltd certifies that the materials and components used in our products originate outside of the conflict region.

Testbourne Ltd will continue to work with our suppliers to strengthen compliance and ensure that only “Conflict Free” materials are purchased.
